



The children in play group have completed 3 months in New Horizon Vidya Mandir, settling in comfortably in the school. Being their first step in a school environment, the children have come a long way in such a short period of time. The children have adjusted to their environment beautifully with increased levels of interactions with their teachers and peers.

In the last 3 months, the focus has been on physical activity to improve on gross motor skill development and on fine muscle development through play with blocks and action rhymes. Social interaction and behaviour has also been a big development with the children learning to play with their peers, learning to be responsible for their belongings, keeping their immediate environment tidy, eating in a timely manner and following simple instructions.
